

NIGUIRI SHRIMP

MATERIALS

- Red cotton yarn
- Pink cotton yarn
- White cotton yarn
- Off white cotton yarn
- Fiber fill
- Yarn needle
- 2,0 mm hook

Sushi for everybody!

SHRIMP

- 1- 5 ch (off white).....(5st)
- 2- insert your hook in 2^a chain from hook to continue, 4sc.....(4st)
- 3- ch, turn, 4sc(4st)
- 4- chct pink, ch, turn, 4sc.....(4st)
- 5- ch, turn, 4sc.....(4st)
- 6- chct red, ch, turn, 4sc... ..(4st)
- 7- chct off white, ch, turn, 4sc.....(4st)
- 8- ch, turn, sk 1st, 3sc.....(3st)
- 9- ch, turn, sk 1st, 2sc.....(2st)
- 10- chct pink, ch, turn, 2sc.....(2st)
- 11- ch, turn, 2sc.....(2st)
- 12- chct red, ch, turn, 2sc.....(2st)
- 13- 4ch, turn, 1hdc in the 2^o st from hook, 1dec in the remaining 2 chains, join with a 1slst in the first chain of the starting chain, 1slst in next stitch, 4ch, 1hdc in the 2^o stitch from hook, 1dec in the remaining 2 chains, join with a 1slst in the first chain of the starting chain.
- 14- chct of white, rotate 90 degrees clockwise, 10sc through the side of the tail, rotate 90 degrees clockwise and work through the foundation chain: °2dc, 1hdc°, 1slst, sk 1p, °1hdc, 2dc°, rotate 90 degrees clockwise and crochet 10sc through the other side of of the shrimp tail. Break the yarn and fasten off leaving a tail for sewing closing a little the shrimp tail, and also for sewing it to the niguri.

That's the way the shrimp looks like before sewing it

ABBREVIATIONS

- ch = chain
- inc= increase
- sk= skip stitch
- dec= decrease
- slst= sleep stitch
- sc= single crochet
- dc= double crochet
- chct= change color to...
- hdc= half double crochet
- °...°= work all stitches between °and° into the same stitch
- [...] x times= repeat instructions in brackets as sequence as many times as written after the closing bracket

NIGURI

- 1- 9 ch (white).....(9st)
 - 2- insert your hook in 2^a chain from hook to continue, 7sc, 1 inc (in last chain) now you have to continue through the other side of the foundation chain, 7sc, 1inc.....(18st)
 - 3- 1inc, 6sc, 1 inc, 1sc, 1 inc, 6sc, 1inc, 1sc.....(22st)
 - 4- 2sc, 1inc, 4sc, 1inc, 5sc, 1inc, 4sc, 1inc, 3sc.....(26st)
 - 5- 2sc, 1inc, 6sc, 1inc, 5sc, 1inc, 6sc, 1inc, 3sc.....(30st)
 - 6-9- 30sc (4 rounds).....(30st)
- Start stuffing the the niguri with fiber fill.
- 10- [3sc, 1dec] x6(24st)
 - 11- [2sc, 1dec] x6.....(18st)
 - 12- [1sc, 1dec] x6.....(12st)

Break the yarn and fasten off leaving a tail for sewing, and close the remaining stitches through the front loops.

Join slightly with a few stitches the narrowest part of the shrimp tail
