



# NIGUIRI TAMAGO

## MATERIALS

*Sushi for everybody!*

White cotton yarn  
Black cotton yarn  
Yellow cotton yarn

Fiber fill  
Yarn needle  
2,0 mm hook

## ABBREVIATIONS

- ch = chain
- inc= increase
- sc= single crochet
- dec= decrease
- bb= work the stitch trough back bump only
- [...] x times= repeat instructions in brackets as sequence as many times as written after the closing bracket

## NIGUIRI

- 1- 9 ch (white).....(9st)
- 2- insert your hook in 2<sup>a</sup> chain fom hook to continue, 7sc, 1 inc (in last chain)now you have to continue trough the other side of the foundation chain, 7sc, 1inc.....(18st)
- 3- 1inc, 6sc, 1 inc, 1sc, 1 inc, 6sc, 1inc, 1sc.....(22st)
- 4- 2sc, 1inc, 4sc, 1inc, 5sc, 1inc, 4sc, 1inc, 3sc.....(26st)
- 5- 2sc, 1inc, 6sc, 1inc, 5sc, 1inc, 6sc, 1inc, 3sc.....(30st)
- 6-9- 30sc (4 rounds).....(30st)

Start stuffing the the niguri with fiber fill.

- 10- [3sc, 1dec] x6 .....(24st)
- 11- [2sc, 1dec] x6.....(18st)
- 12- [1sc, 1dec] x6.....(12st)

Break the yarn and fasten off leaving a tail for sewing, and close the remaining stitches through the front loops.

## OMELETTE

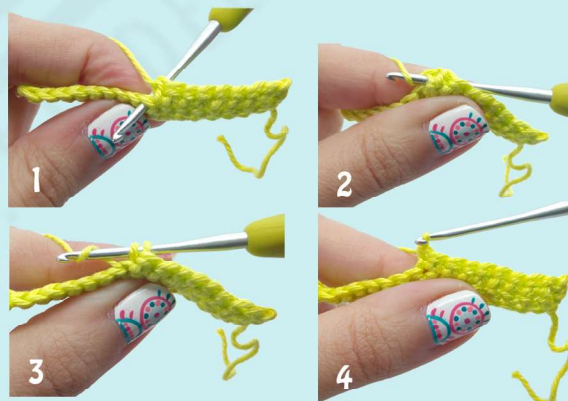
- 1- 12 ch (yellow).....(12st)
  - 2- insert your hook in 2<sup>a</sup> chain fom hook to continue, 11sc bb (pictures).....(11st)
  - 3- ch, turn, 11sc reverse crochet (pictures).....(11st)
  - 4- ch, turn, 11sc.....(11st)
- Now repeat 3 and 4 rounds alternately, twice.  
Break the yarn and fasten off leaving a tail for sewing the salmon slice over niguri's narrow side.

## NORI SEAWEED

- 1- 19 ch (black) .....(19st)
  - 2- insert your hook in 2<sup>a</sup> chain fom hook to continue, 18pb xbt.....(18st)
- Break the yarn and fasten off leaving a tail for sewing the nori seaweed from side to side.

Back bump is the horizontal loop behind the chain. If you work through the bump, the edge of the piece will be straight.

## REVERSE CROCHET

Insert your hook through the opposit side of the stitch (picture 1). Yarn over above and pull it through the stitch (picture 2). Yarn over normally and pull it through the 2 loops in the hook (pictures 3 y 4).
