

NIGUIRI SALMON

MATERIALS

White cotton yarn
Orange cotton yarn
2,0 mm hook

Fiber fill
Yarn needle

Sushi for everybody!

cad = chain
inc= increase
sk= skip stitch
slst= sleep stitch
dec= decrease
sc= single crochet

blo= work the stitch trough back loop only
[...] x times= repeat instructions in brackets as sequence as many times as written after the closing bracket

ABBREVIATIONS

SALMON SLICE

- 1- 4ch(salmon).....(4st)
- 2- insert your hook in 2^a chain fom hook to continue, 2sc, 1inc.....(4st)
- 3- ch, turn, 3sc, 1inc.....(5st)
- 4- ch, turn, 4sc, 1inc.....(6st)
- 5- ch, turn, 5sc, 1inc.....(7st)
- 6-9- ch, turn, 7sc(7st)
- 10 - ch, turn, sk 1, 6sc.....(6st)
- 11- ch, turn, sk 1, 5sc.....(5st)
- 12- ch, turn, sk 1, 4sc.....(4st)
- 13- ch, turn, sk 1, 3sc.....(3st)
- 14- ch, turn, sk 1, 2sc.....(2st)
- 15- ch, turn, sk 1, 1sc.....(1st)

Fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing

Embroider a few white lines to simulate salmon's fat

NIGUIRI

- 1- 9 ch (white).....(9st)
- 2- insert your hook in 2^a chain fom hook to continue, 7sc, 1 inc (in last chain)now you have to continue trough the other side of the foundation chain,7sc, 1inc.....(18st)
- 3- 1inc, 6sc, 1 inc, 1sc, 1 inc, 6sc, 1inc, 1sc.....(22st)
- 4- 2sc, 1inc, 4sc, 1inc, 5sc, 1inc, 4sc, 1inc, 3sc.....(26st)
- 5- 2sc, 1inc, 6sc, 1inc, 5sc, 1inc, 6sc, 1inc, 3sc.....(30st)
- 6-9- 30sc (4 rounds).....(30st)
Start stuffing the the nigiri with fiber fill.
- 10- [3sc, 1dec] x6(24st)
- 11- [2sc, 1dec] x6.....(18st)
- 12- [1sc, 1dec] x6.....(12st)

Break the yarn and fasten off leaving a tail for sewing, and close the remaining stitches through the front loops.

Sew the salmon slice over nigiri's narrow side
