

# TERRÓN THE MUG

Pattern by DESDE LAS NUBES



## MATERIALS

2,0 mm hook  
Blue cotton yarn  
White cotton yarn  
Pink cotton yarn  
Black cotton yarn

Fiber fill  
Cream color felt  
5 mm safety eyes  
Textile glue  
Rigid plastic (optional)  
Handful of chickpeas (optional)



## ABBREVIATIONS

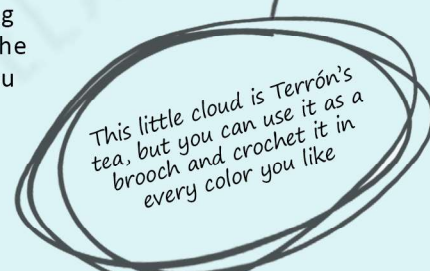
**dc**= double crochet  
**inc**= increase  
**ch**= chain  
**sc**= single crochet  
**slst**= sleep stitch  
**tr**= triple crochet stitch

**st** = stitch  
**hdc**= half double crochet  
**tbl**= through back loops only  
°...°= work all stitches between °and° into the same stitch  
**[...] x times**= repeat instructions in brackets as sequence as many times as written after the "x"

## CLOUD

- 1- Crochet 9 ch as a beginning. insert your hook in 2 ch from hook to continue: 1 hdc, 5 dc, 1 hdc, °2 hdc, 1 dc° in the las stitch of the chain.
- 2- Now you have to work through the other side of the initial chain: °1 hdc, 1 slst°, 1 inc-dc, 1 sc, 1 inc-tr, °1 tr, 1 hdc°, 1 slst, 1 inc.

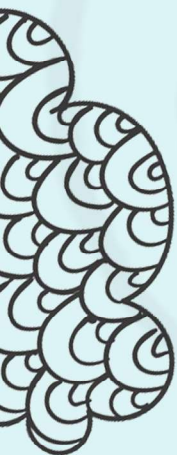
Break the yarn, close with an invisible fasten off and leaving a long tail for sewing. You have to sew the tail through the back side of the cloud, to the top center of the cloud so you can "hang" it to the mug.

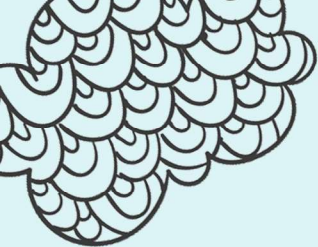


This little cloud is Terrón's tea, but you can use it as a brooch and crochet it in every color you like

## HANDLE

- 1- 25 sc in a magic ring.....(25st)  
Don't close ring's center and keep going with spiral crocheting
- 2- [1sc, 1 inc] x 12, 1sc.....(37st)  
Break the yarn leaving a really long tail. Fold the circle in a half creating a "bridge" shape, and pull the begin tail to place stitches properly, as you can see in the photo down here. Sew and join both sides though the inside loops, to create the handle.





# MUG

- 1- 6 sc in a magic ring .....(6st)
- 2- 6 inc .....(12st)
- 3- [1 sc, 1 inc] x6 .....(18st)
- 4- [2 sc, 1 inc]x6 .....(24st)
- 5- [3 sc, 1 inc]x6 .....(30st)
- 6- [4 sc, 1 inc]x6 .....(36st)
- 7- [5 sc, 1 inc]x6 .....(42st)
- 8- [6 sc, 1 inc]x6 .....(48st)
- 9- [7 sc, 1 inc]x6 .....(54st)
- 10- 54 sc tbl .....(54st)
- 11-29 (19 rounds) 54sc .....(54st)

You can place a rigid plastic circle at the bottom of the mug with uncooked chickpeas or rice, to give stability to the base and weight so it doesn't knock over when using it. After putting the eyes, the cheeks, the handle and embroidering the mouth, fill the rest of the mug and adjust the fibres in the inside giving them shape with the help of a small stick, to press it all in the desired shape.

To close the mug use textile glue to glue a felt circle as a lid. You can also crochet a lid repeating rounds 1 to 9 with cream coloured thread. Finally, sew the excess thread of the cloud to the cream piece and place your coloured pins.

Break the yarn and close with an invisible fasten off



# CHEEKS (make 2)

- 1- 6 sc in a magic ring..... (6st)

Make a sleep stitch (slst) into the first stitch to close the circle. Break the yarn leaving a long tail for an invisible fasten off and for sewing.

Place safety eyes between rounds 18 and 19 with 7 stitches of distance. Embroider the mouth with black yarn between rounds 15 and 16, as you can see in the pictures. Sew the cheeks between rounds 14 and 17 on both sides of the face, and the Handle on the side between rounds 15 and 24.



# TERRÓN (THAT MEANS SUGAR CUBE)
