



# CALIFORNIA ROLL

## MATERIALS

- White cotton yarn
- Black cotton yarn
- Orange cotton yarn
- Pistachio cotton yarn
- Green cotton yarn

*Sushi for everybody!*

- Fiber fill
- Yarn needle
- 2,0 mm hook

## CALIFORNIA ROLL AVOCADO

- 1- 6 sc in a magic ring (salmon).....(6sts)
- 2- 4 inc, chct green, 2 dc.....(12sts)
- 3- chct white, [1sc, 1inc] x 6.....(18sts)
- 4- [2sc, 1inc] x 6.....(24sts)
- 5- 24 sc blo.....(24sts)
- 6-12- 24 sc (7 rounds).....(24sts)

- ### ABBREVIATIONS
- ch = chain
  - inc= increase
  - slst= sleep stitch
  - sc= single crochet
  - chct= change color to...
  - blo= work the stitch trough back loop only
  - [...] x times= repeat instructions in brackets as sequence as many times as written after the closing bracket

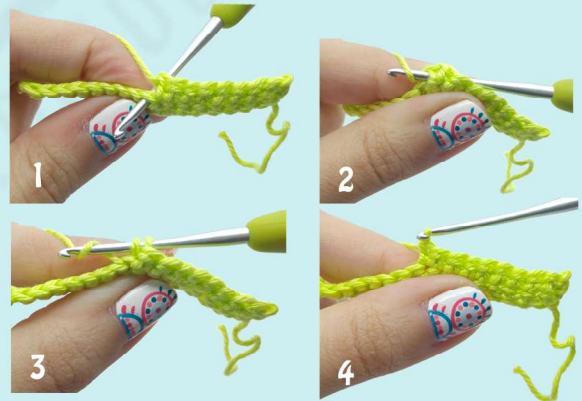
Break the yarn and close with an invisible fasten off. Now you have to crochet another piece repeating rounds 1 to 4. Fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing. Stuff the big piece with fiber fill and close it with the second one. Sew them each other through the front loop of both pieces.

## AVOCADO SLICES (MAKE 2)

- 1- 19 ch (pistachio), turn .....(19sts)
  - 2- insert your hook in 2<sup>a</sup> chain from hook to continue, 18sc .....(18sts)
  - 3- ch, turn, 18sc reverse crochet (see pictures) .....(18sts)
- Break the yarn leaving a long tail for sewing. Incorporate green cotton yarn in the last stitch of last round and continue.
- 4- 18sc.....(18sts)
- Fasten off

Knit 2 pieces like this one and sew them on the California Roll

Detail!! You can embroider a black line around the second round, to simulate the nori seaweed



## REVERSE CROCHET

Insert your hook through the opposite side of the stitch (picture 1). Yarn over above and pull it through the stitch (picture 2). Yarn over normally and pull it through the 2 loops in the hook (pictures 3 y 4).
