

# RAINBOW BIRTHDAY CAKE

## CAKE TOP



### ABBREVIATIONS

- ch= chain
- inc= increase
- slst= slip stitch
- tr= triple crochet
- sc= single crochet
- dc= double crochet
- hdc= half double crochet
- bl= through back loops only
- fl= through front loops only
- (...) x veces= repeat instructions in brackets as sequence as many times as written after the "x"
- °...°= work stitches between symbols into the same stitch

We will work in rounds in which the chain stitch before turning won't count as a stitch. We will begin (in white) with 2 chains and continue crocheting from the second chain from the hook.

- 1- 1inc, 1 ch, turn.....(2st)
- 2- 1sc, 1inc, 1ch, turn.....(3st)
- 3- 1sc, 1inc, 1sc, 1ch, turn.....(4st)
- 4- 1sc, °1sc, 1hdc°, 1hdc, 1sc, 1ch, turn.....(5st)
- 5- 1sc, 1hdc, 1inc-hdc, 1hdc, 1sc, 2ch, turn.....(6st)
- 6- 1hdc, 1dc, 2inc-dc, 1dc, 1hdc, 2ch, turn.....(8st)
- 7- 1hdc, 2dc, 2inc-dc, 2dc, 1hdc, 2ch, turn.....(10st)
- 8- 1hdc, 3dc, 2inc-dc, 3dc, 1hdc, 2ch, turn.....(12st)
- 9- 1hdc, 4dc, 2inc-dc, 4dc, 1hdc, 3ch, turn.....(14st)
- 10- 1dc, 4tr, 4inc-tr, 4tr, 1dc, turn.....(18st)
- 11- (2ch, 1slst-bl, 3ch, 1slst-bl)x9, 1ch

we turn the piece 90 degrees and continue crocheting 14slst in the spaces on the side of the piece until we reach the corner, 2ch, 14slst on the other side, 1ch, and continue crocheting on the 18 fl that were left free on the 11 round: 18sc, 1ch, turn.

- 12-23-(12 rounds) 18sc, 1ch turn.....(18st)

Break the yarn and close with an invisible fasten off.

## CAKE BOTTOM AND LAYERS

Do a repetition of round 1 to 10 from the cake top part, with blue yarn. Then we have to crochet 1ch and 14slst in the spaces on one side of the piece until we reach the vertex, 2ch, 14slst on the other side, 2ch, turn.

- 11-(1dc-fl, 1sc-fl) x15..... (30st)
- 12-13- 2ch, turn (1dc, 1sc)x15.....(30st)
- 14- change color to white, 1ch, turn, 30slst-fl.....(30st)
- 15-change color to yellow, 2 ch, turn, we will crochet this round through the bl of the 13 blue round (1dc, 1sc)x15.....(30st)
- 16-17- 2ch, turn (1dc, 1sc)x15.....(30st)
- 18-change color to white, 1ch, turn, 30slst-fl.....(30st)
- 19-change color to orange, 2ch, turn, we will crochet this round through the bl of the 17 yellow round (1dc, 1sc)x15.. (30st)
- 20-21- 2ch, turn (1dc, 1sc)x15.....(30st)

Fasten off and close

For the edge, what we're going to do is grab a white thread and stitch it through the spaces of the different colored layers to join them together (3sc, 1ch)x3, 1ch, turn 90 degrees to stitch the upper orange border: 30sc, 1ch, turn another 90 degrees to stitch the other border to the spaces in the other colored layers: (3sc, 1ch)x3, fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing.

When putting the cake together, we can put a piece of hard plastic with the shape of the base at the bottom, to make sure that it will stay flat once we fill it up. That way, once we put the cake down on a flat surface it will stay stable and not fall to the sides. Fill the cake up with fiber fill and then stitch it up together.

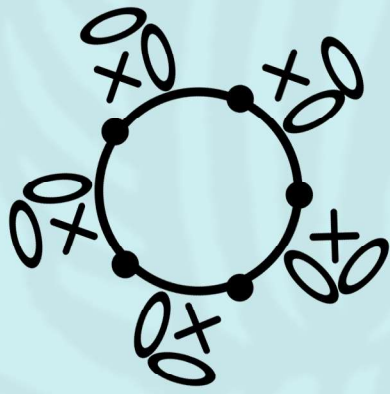


# CANDLE BOTTOM

# MATERIALS

- 2mm crochet hook
- Orange cotton yarn
- Yellow cotton yarn
- White cotton yarn
- Beige cotton yarn
- Blue cotton yarn
- Red cotton yarn
- Wool needle
- Fiber fill

1- Using the red thread, we start by creating a magic ring: (2ch, 1sc in the second ch from hook, 1slst in the ring)x5 and close the ring. Cut and fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing



## DIAGRAM

- o chain
- + single crochet
- sleep stitch

# CANDLE

- 1- In beige color, 1 magic ring with 6sc.....(6st)
- 2- 6sc.....(6st)
- 3- change to red, 6sc.....(6st)
- 4- change to beige, 6sc.....(6st)
- 5- change to red, 6sc.....(6st)
- 6-7- change to beige, 6sc.....(6st)

Fansten off and cut leaving a long tail for sewing

# FLAME

To do the flame what we have to do is knot together two threads, one yellow and one orange, with another longer orange one which will then serve to sew it together with the candle. Afterwards, we brush the threads with a metallic bristles (a brush for pets) to create that fire effect once the threads fray.



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
