MATERIALS

Sushi for everyone!

- White cotton yarn
- Black cotton yarn
- Green cotton yarn
- Cream cotton yarn
- Salmon cotton yarn

- Fiber fill
- Yarn needle
- 2,0 mm hook

ABBREVIATIONS

- inc**= increase
- sc**= single crochet
- slst**= sleep stitch
- chct**= change color to...
- blo**= work the stitch trough back loop only
- [...] x times**= repeat instructions in brackets as sequence as many times as written after the closing bracket

CALIFORNIA ROLL

- 1- 6 sc in a magic ring (salmon).....(6sts)
- 2- 4 inc, chct green, 2 dc.....(12sts)
- 3- chct white, [1sc, 1inc] x 6.....(18sts)
- 4- [2sc, 1inc] x 6.....(24sts)
- 5- 24 sc blo.....(24sts)
- 6-12- 24 sc (7 rounds).....(24sts)

Break the yarn and close with an invisible fasten off. Now you have to crochet another piece repeating rounds 1 to 4. Fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing. Embroider a few sesame seeds with black and cream yarn cotton around the cilinder. Stuff the big piece with fiber fill and close it with the second one. Sew them each other through the front loop of both pieces.

*Detail!!
You can embroider a black line around the second round, to simulate the nori seaweed*

By using pearl cotton nº 5, you can knit a perfect brooch
